SOLS 24/7 and GULL: 24 April 12

Science of Life Systems (SOLS) 24/7 has affiliated with GULL with the aim of providing a professional Bachelor degree pathway for the many thousands of youngsters from poor communities in its multi-country network. SOLS is a non-governmental, non-religious organization that is dedicated to providing a free education to youngsters who would otherwise have little or no educational opportunity. SOLS has developed a unique 'smart' concept for its holistic development process that embraces both character and competence development and during the past 12 years they have trained more than 80,000 young people. SOLS began working in Cambodia in 2000 and extended its work to East Timor (2006), Malaysia (2007), Laos in 2010 and Thailand in 2012.

SOLS was founded by Madenjit Singh who grew up in a poor family of five boys and seven girls in Banda Hilir, Malacca, Malaysia. His family's situation motivated him to establish SOLS so as to provide community-based education for disadvantaged youngsters. Affectionately known as 'Big Teacher' Madenjit and his family are making a significant difference in serving the poor and the marginalized.
